Friends of the Sir Alexander Galt Museum

Funding will support the development of new video content for the “Blackfoot Immersive Experience” at Fort Whoop-up. This new interactive experience is being developed in collaboration with the Reconciliation Lethbridge Advisory Committee for a Fall 2021 launch.

McNally Community Association

Funding will be used to make ensure safe, year-round accessibility to the community centre by replacing and repaving the concrete flatwork around a new accessibility ramp
