Youth in Action 2021

The Youth in Action Granting Program supports charitable initiatives organized by residents of Southwestern Alberta up to the age of 25, in collaboration with a charitable partner. The following six recipients of 2021's Youth in Action grants received a combined total of \$7,600 for their projects.

Coalhurst High School, \$700: To purchase cameras for use by members of the Yearbook Club and for students wishing to photograph community events.

Raymond Elementary School, \$1,400: To support the development of a school community garden for students and residents to use and enjoy.

Stitch It Forward Society of Lethbridge, \$2,000: To purchase supplies for emergency feminine hygiene kits, which will be made available to students throughout middle and high schools in Lethbridge.

Volunteer Lethbridge, \$2,000 (\$1,000 from the David and Shirley Hughes Fund): To support an initiative for students to design and build cigarette waste receptacles. The collected waste will be sold to a recycling company and the proceeds will be distributed to local charities.

Winston Churchill High School, Lethbridge, \$500: To purchase supplies and resources to outfit a school Student Wellness Centre, to promote positive mental health for students.

YouthONE, Lethbridge, \$1,000: For a partnership with High Level Tutoring Services, an instruction and mentoring program designed and run by and for students in Lethbridge.
